1 MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND SMALL BREEDS

Open to Mountain and Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh A and Welsh B. Stallion, mare or gelding 4 years and over. Riders any age except for those on stallions who must have attained their 14th birthday by 1st January of the current year and suitably mounted. Spurs must not be worn.

2 MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND LARGE BREEDS

Open to Mountain and Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Fells, Dales, Highlands, New Forests, Connemara, Welsh C and Welsh D. Stallion, mare or gelding 4 years and over. Riders any age except for those on stallions who must have attained their 14th birthday by 1st January of the current year. Spurs must not be worn.

3 LEAD REIN MOUNTAIN AND MOOLAND

Open to Mountain and Moorland ponies registered with their Pure Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A or B. Mares or geldings 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cm. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but not have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle, the lead rein to be attached to the noseband only.

4 FIRST RIDDEN MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND

Open to Mountain and Moorland ponies registered with their Pure Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A or B. Mares or geldings 4 years old and over not exceeding 128cm. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be shown in any suitable bridle.

CHAMPIONSHIP 1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 1 - 4

5 COLOURED PONY

Open Ridden Piebald/Skewbald, stallion, mare or gelding 4 years and over. Riders any age except for those on stallions who must have attained their 14th birthday by 1st January of the current year. Spurs must not be worn. Ponies under 153 cms. This class may be split into Native and Non-Native at the final.

6 PLAITED PONY

Open plaited pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 148cms. Any suitably mounted rider. Spurs must not be worn

7 LEAD REIN PLAITED PONY

Lead Rein Pony mare or gelding not exceeding 128cms. Riders to have attained their 3rd birthday but not their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle. Lead rein to be attached to the noseband only.

8 FIRST RIDDEN PLAITED PONY

First Ridden Pony, mare or gelding not exceeding 128cm. Riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be shown in any suitable bridle. 9 RIDING CLUB PONY

Open Riding Club Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Not Exceeding 148cms. Lead reins not permitted. Spurs must not be worn.

10 COLOURED HORSE

Open Ridden Piebald/Skewbald, stallion, mare or gelding 4 years and over. Riders any age except for those on stallions who must have attained their 14th birthday by 1st January of the current year Spurs may be worn by adult riders. Animals 153cms and over This class may be split into Native and Non-Native at the final.

11 RIDDEN RIDING HORSE/HACK

Open to Hacks and Riding Horses. mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Exceeding 148cms but Hacks not exceeding 160cms. Riders must have attained their 15th birthday by the day of the Show. Spurs may be worn by adult riders.

12 RIDDEN COB

Open Ridden Cob, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Exceeding 148cms. To be shown hogged and trimmed. Riders must have attained their 15th birthday by the day of the Show Spurs may be worn by adult riders.

13 RIDDEN HUNTER

Open Ridden Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Exceeding 148cms. Riders must have attained their 15th birthday by the day of the Show. Spurs may be worn by adult riders. 14 RIDING CLUB HORSE

Open Riding Club Horse, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Exceeding 148cms. Riders must have attained their 15th birthday by the day of the Show. Spurs may be worn by adult riders.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. OPEN AND LOCAL CLASSES All classes are open unless otherwise specified. To qualify as an exhibitor in a "Local" class an exhibitor must normally reside within 7 miles of Mottram church and the exhibit must have been in the exhibitor's possession for not less than 4 weeks immediately before the show.
- 2. JUDGES DECISION The judges decision is final.
- 3. CUPS AND TROPHIES All cups and trophies are to be signed for and returned to the Cup Secretary, not later than 1st August following the show.

- 4. PROTESTS AND OBJECTIONS Any protest or objection must be made to the show secretary in writing accompanied by a deposit of £20 at the show. The deposit will be retained by the Society if in the opinion of the committee the objection is deemed to be frivolous. Any protests or objections will be considered by the committee at the show or at a subsequent committee meeting.
- 6. AGE No horse or pony under the age of 4 years is to be ridden on the showground. Horses and ponies age by 1 year on the 1st January each year. Children in ridden classes must have attained their 4th birthday by the date of the show. Age of other riders and handlers is to be at the 1st January of the current year.
- 7. SAFETY All riders must wear correct standard hard hats and appropriate riding clothing. For in-hand class, under 16s must wear hard hats, all other handlers must wear suitable headwear. Any competitor deemed not in control of their animal will be asked to leave the showground. All dogs must be kept on leads.
- 8. A NOVICE is a horse or pony that has not won a prize of £5 or above in any ridden class before 1st. January 2025.
- 9. COLTS and STALLIONS Colts and Stallions must be ridden or handled by a competent person over 14 years old, Stallions should wear a stallion disc.
- 10. WHIPS Whips exceeding 30inches are not allowed.
- 11. The published times are for guidance only. It is the competitor's responsibility to present themselves in the ring for the start of the class. No responsibility can be accepted for competitor's having entered in classes which run simultaneously in different rings. No competitor will be allowed to re-enter the ring having once left it.
- 12. Handlers of Lead Rein ponies must be at least 14 years of age.
